Oxford's park&ride is the easiest way to get into Oxford City Centre by car. Simply leave your car at one of the five park&ride sites located around the city and enjoy a quick and stress-free journey into the City Centre on our diesel-electric hybrid buses.

Fast & more frequent park&ride

We operate a frequent service to and from each of the park&ride sites. This includes a service up to every 10 minutes to and from the Pear Tree and Redbridge car parks.

With such a frequent bus service from all of the five park&ride sites and with bus lanes into the City Centre along every route, getting in to Oxford couldn't be quicker

Keeping our city low-carbon

We use diesel-electric hybrid buses on all of our park&ride routes. This means that when you leave your car at one of the five park&ride sites around the city and travel in on the bus, you will be making a major contribution to keeping Oxford's air clean, as well as helping to reduce traffic congestion.
