park&ride

Oxford's park&ride is the easiest way to get into Oxford City Centre by car. Simply leave your car at one of the five park&ride sites located around the city and enjoy a quick and stress-free journey into the City Centre on our diesel-electric hybrid buses.

Fast & more frequent park&ride

We operate a frequent service to and from each of the park&ride sites. This includes a service up to every 10 minutes to and from the Pear Tree and Redbridge car parks.

With such a frequent bus service from all of the five park&ride sites and with bus lanes into the City Centre along every route, getting in to Oxford couldn't be quicker

Keeping our city low-carbon

We use diesel-electric hybrid buses on all of our park&ride routes. This means that when you leave your car at one of the five park&ride sites around the city and travel in on the bus, you will be making a major contribution to keeping Oxford's air clean, as well as helping to reduce traffic congestion.



Stay Late

We operate until late in the evening on Mondays to Saturdays back to all park&ride sites. See the individual timetables for further details.

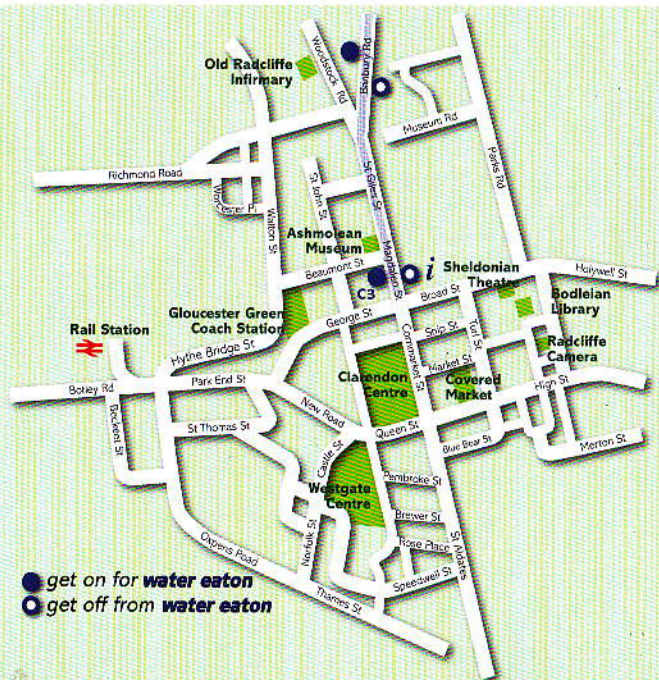
There are no buses from Water Eaton on Sundays.

Return buses to Water Eaton Mon-Sat evenings after 1900 are **red Oxford Bus Company** buses numbered 2, 2A & 2B and drop you off on the main road outside the car park. They leave from stop C1 (near C3) and Keble Road.

Please ask the driver to stop at Water Eaton when you board.

Time shown for last park&ride 500 (1912) bus back is at Magdalen Street, stop C3. Later buses numbered 2, 2A & 2B depart from stop C1.

Leave the car at Thornhill park&ride and enjoy a quick and comfortable ride into London on the X90.



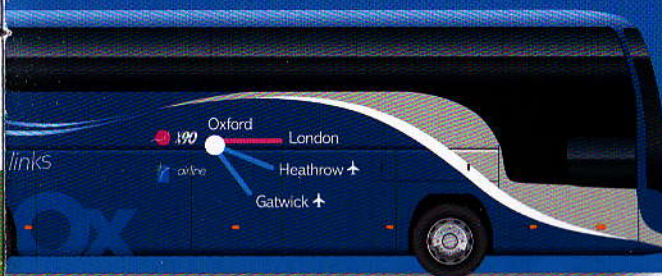
